# Erin Woods Community Association Board Meeting Minutes November 13, 2023

Meeting was called to order at 7:05

Approval of agenda - Kassi J. approved; passed

Adoption of the General meeting minutes from October 2 2023 – Dennis C. adopted; passed

Reports to Board and related business

- 1. City NPC Stephan Horbay
- New grants were hilited
- Lifecycle quotes for the CCG grant need to be in by November 30, 2023 for this year's allocation
- The cancelled strategic planning meeting will be rescheduled. As per the City of Calgary it is overdue

#### 2: Safety Director - Heather Jensen

- Erin Woods Crime Activity was Down in September 2023
   Erin Woods Calgary experienced 3 crimes in September 2023, in comparison to 7 crimes the previous month, and 13 crimes in September one year ago. The Erin Woods community has an average of 10.8 crimes per month. On an annual basis, Erin Woods had a total of 130 crimes as of September 2023, which is down 21% in comparison to 164 crimes as of September 2022. Total Erin Woods community crimes is calculated as the sum of break & enters (dwelling, commercial, and other premises), theft from vehicles, theft of vehicles, assaults (nondomestic), commercial robberies, street robberies, and non-domestic 'other' violence.
- What else can I do to Secure My Home and Property? The Calgary Police Service encourages Calgarians to establish a 9 PM Secure Your Home and Property Routine before heading to bed. The routine recommends: Removing valuables from vehicles | Ensuring vehicles are locked, windows are closed and if possible, parked in a garage | Closing garage doors and windows | Locking any person-doors in the garage, including those leading into a house | Checking that all house doors front, back, side and garage are locked | Ensuring all windows are shut | Turning on an exterior light.
- Cat walks (Community Action Team) are going well. Had a couple of walks where a few issues were reported. Talked to a few homeless and told them about resources to check out for food and shelter. 12 CSI has been very successful in getting many homeless off the street. The walks will resume when weather permits.

#### 3: 2nd Vice President and 3 Way Sign Co-ordinator – Dennis Cave

Update on Children's Christmas party

- Reached out to some community groups; none have responded back
- The Champion Life Centre has not responded yet. Shannon C. will reach out to them too.
- Rick Ryan from the Scout group will offer scouts help with the Christmas party
- Carolyn offered to pick up the groceries for the goodie bags



#### Update on Skating Lessons

- The lessons have been cancelled due to lack of internal support
- 4. Treasurer & Community Garden John Stark Absent
  - The community garden is closed for the winter
- 5. ECTAS Director: Anne Miller
  - The AGM barely made quorum. The bylaws are not ready. A special resolution meeting will be held at a later date. Erin Woods will be notified of this meeting.
- 6: The community fridge project Christina Y. and John Stark
  - This project has been shut down at moment due to circumstances beyond our control. Once the weather improves, we will resume work on our project.
- 7: Rink Co-ordinator- Jonathan Masri
  - Been busy putting together a team of rink volunteers. As soon as the steady, deep cold arrives the building and flooding will take place.
  - Rick Ryan the scouts need to earn their rink rat badge. They will discuss how and when the scouts can help
- 8: Fundraising & Grants Director- Melody H
  - The Toole Peet Action Grant was applied for to offset the cost of renting the horse drawn sleigh for the Children's Christmas party
  - Spoke with the grant-giver at ChangeX regarding the pause in the Community Fridge project, and they confirmed
    we have until March 2024 to report on any impact. I did indicate to them we would be unable to make progress
    on the project over the winter, so I plan to reach out to them in February 2024 to see about extending our
    timeframe.
  - Work is in progress to get quotes for the work on the building (as indicated by the Lifecycle Plan) that we will
    apply to cover with the Capital Conservation Grant and the Community Facilities Enhancement Project. You can
    expect an email motion to be proposed once we have the quotes in place to approve going forward with the
    proposals.
- 9: Communications Director Kassi J.
  - As per a development permit sent out by the City of Calgary; there is a proposal for an A&W in the Petro Gas Station area. This could be problematic due to traffic getting in and out.
  - No vote needed for Kassi and Christina to cochair organization of the community cleanup
  - Kassi J. is appointed as community clean-up co-ordinator



- All preliminary tasks for the community clean-up are taken care of through the office. Kassi will be responsible to organize all volunteers for the day of the event. At least 12 volunteers will be needed. Heather J. suggested reaching out to the Rotary Club for volunteers.
- Anne M. noted that all postings in relation to the Community Centre need to be sent to Shannon C. Once the
  posting is put onto the Erin Woods Facebook page it will be shared to the Erin Woods residents Facebook page.
  Anne M. will be working on a social media policy.

Erinwoods had 5 crimes in November compared to 10 in 2022. Erinwoods has 10.1 on average. Total crime as off November 121 down 26% compared to 164 in 2022 till November. These stats don't take into account count social & physical disorder. We rank 62nd in Calgary community crime. With a 12 month average of 1.43 per capita. Social disorder - numbers reflect public perception of crime and safety because it is based on reports of suspicions of potential crime rather than specific crime that police will investigate. Social disorder for 2023 on reported crimes was at 278 down from 2022 down 54 instances.

Physical disorder-Vacant or abandoned housing, vandalized and run-down buildings, abandoned cars, graffiti, and litter in the streets Physical disorder for 2023 with total of 22 down from 2022 by 6 instances.
